NWU Research Themes



Energy Research groups at the NWU:

- *The NWU Research Unit for Energy Systems. The Unit focuses on various energy-related research projects. The NWU was i.a. tasked to **develop a renewable energy plan for the North-West Province.***
- *The **DST HySA Infrastructure Centre of Competence in Hydrogen.** This centre is co-hosted by the NWU and the CSIR, with NWU as lead party, and focuses on Hydrogen production, storage, reticulation and safety and standards.*
- *The NWU hosts research chairs in **coal research** and **nuclear engineering** (SARCHI), and an ESKOM research chair in **emission control.***

A BRICS Nodal Office for Research, Training and Collaboration was established in the VC's Office
